Vint Thesis

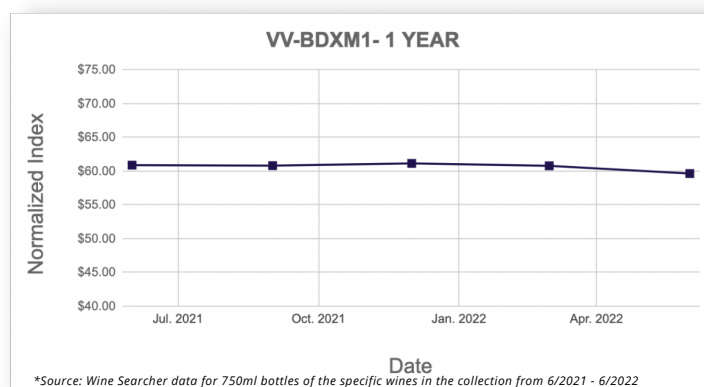
The name, "Bordeaux Superstars", perfectly encapsulates the unique value proposition presented by this selection of wines in magnum format. From Vint's perspective, to be considered a "Bordeaux Superstar", a wine must be made by one of the elite producers, and be from a top vintage. This collection fulfills the first requirement by featuring four of the five First Growth wines from the Left Bank, and Cheval Blanc, one of the top wines from the Right Bank. The vintage requirement is met five times over, with the wines in this collection heralding from arguably the top five Bordeaux vintages of the past 20 years. The resulting collection features four 100-point wines and seven wines scored over 98-points.

The quality and merit of this collection is further enhanced by the fact that the Bordeaux Superstars in Magnum Collection is exclusively made up of 1.5L bottles, also known as "magnums". Large-format Bordeaux is highly sought-after by collectors due to the limited numbers in which they are produced and their slower aging process, allowing the wines to develop elegantly and live longer in the bottle.

Regardless of format, the wines of Bordeaux remain the top traded wines by value on the secondary market, making up more than 34% of trade by value on the Liv-Ex 1000 Index in May 2022. The region still holds a substantial lead of 7% over second-place Burgundy as of May 2022 trading data. This data demonstrates that in times of economic uncertainty, collectors and investors turn to the stalwart wines with the longest track record of historical performance.

Our deep relationships and supply chain efficiencies allow us to offer this incredible collection to our investors at the most favorable acquisition price in the United States. The wines are all in their original wooden cases (OWC) and still resting under perfect storage conditions in Bordeaux. Original wooden cases can be integral to maximizing a wine's resale value as they demonstrate the quality of the wine's provenance, feature specific markings or security features to denote authenticity, and are sought-after by collectors.

The combination of the consistent historical performance of Bordeaux wines, the exceptional quality of the specific producers represented, and the added value of the large format bottles makes this collection an essential addition to any portfolio.

KEY POINT #1

Superb wines from the world's premier wine region

Bordeaux remains the #1 region traded by value on the secondary market, making up more than 34.3% of total value traded on Liv-Ex in May 2022, up from 33.2% in April 2022. As the wine market broadens and traditional financial markets experience volatility, buyers are looking to wines with long track records of performance like Bordeaux and Burgundy.

KEY POINT #2

Collection at a favorable entry price relative to the US market price

Vint acquired this collection of large format wines directly from Bordeaux, allowing us to list it at the best US market price. As the wines were sourced directly from negociants, they have perfect provenance and have never left the region having been maintained in optimal storage conditions since release.

KEY POINT #3

Four 100-point wines and five of the top vintages of the past 20 years

This collection features four wines scored 100 points by Robert Parker's Wine Advocate and seven wines scored 98 points or better. These scores proceed from wines out of what many consider to be the five best Bordeaux vintages of the last two decades, including the legendary 2005, 2009, and 2010 vintages.
